Purpose

The purpose of this Report Description is to explain how to display Employee Personal Data in the Integrated HR-Payroll System.

Report Description

The B0037: Employee Personal Data report provides a list of employees who are currently active within the organizational unit selected. This report provides personal details about an employee such as home address, emergency contact information, and birth date.

Report Location

PA: Employee Details

Report Uses

- This report can be used to obtain the permanent addresses for employees if there is a need to mail information to employees' home addresses.
- It can be used to obtain emergency contact information for an individual employee or for all employees within an org unit in the event of a disaster or a state of emergency.

- This report contains date of birth, so it can be used in circumstances where there is a business need to gather this information for a group of employees.
- The report also contains only the month and day of birth date, and it can be used to compile a birthday list for employees within an org unit.

How to Generate This Report

This report is generated after selecting values for the mandatory prompts. All mandatory prompts must have values selected before the Run Icon can be used to generate the report. Mandatory prompts can be identified as mandatory by the exclamation mark inside of the yellow-orange triangle, the square with the checkmark, or the display of (Mandatory).
